The Court being thus constituted the prisoner was set to the bar by the sheriff of the
County into whose custody he was heretofore committed, charged with the felony aforesaid
and the motion for the attorney for the Commonwealth and for sufficient reasons appearing
to the Court, it is ordered that the Court be until Saturday next the 27th instant and
thereupon it is ordered that the prisoner be remanded to jail

deed pay Benjamin Lipp four dollars and Sixty Cts. 2/4 the amount of his account when
sufficient appts shall come to his hands also 62 Cts. of Cts. and account thereof with the Court

An Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of Sarah Sprary and was this day
returned and ordered to be recorded

A list of Conveyances made and acknowledged in the Clerk's office Certified by
two Justices of the peace and admitted to record since the last Court in pursuance of an
act of Assembly in such cases made and provided — which is ordered to be entered of record
James H. Keston and Edwin Dick this day qualified as attorney at Law and
thereupon they are permitted to practice as such in this Court
