Friday came the parties by their attorneys and thereupon came a Jury consisting of James Melchior, Alexander Myrick, Benjamin Branch, Francis Williamson, Elijah Joyner, Henry Bishop, Henry Johnson, Charles Stewart, John Wilson, Robert Harbings, James Tappin and Edward Branch who being elected tried and sworn to enquire of the damages thereof brought hereto Court, a verdict on the word following to wit: The Jury find for plaintiff and assess the damages to be paid to the defendant the sum of seventy seven dollars and fifty cents with interest from September the tenth one thousand eight hundred and twelve until paid.
