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have had legal notice of this action they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff may have execution against the said Defendants for sixty five dollars and ninety six cents the penalty of the said bond and his costs by him about his motion in this behalf expended. And the said defendants in money &c. But this execution may be discharged by the payment of thirty three dollars and forty eight cents with six per centum per annum from the 25<sup>th</sup> day of February 1819 till paid and the costs.

On the motion of Spradley Williams &c. leave is granted them to keep an ordinary at the said Williams till the first day of May next upon their paying the fees and giving bond with security as the Law requires.
