This day came the parties by their counsel and the commissioners appointed under an interlocutory decree made in this cause at March Court 1878. to sell the tract of land of which Drewry Beale died seized. This day made the following report to wit:
"In obedience to the within decree to us directed we have proceeded to sell the within named tract of land to the highest bidder on a credit of twelve months. At which sale Jesse B Drake became the purchaser. and for purchase money the said Drake executed seven bonds with approved security in the following manner to wit. - One bond of one hundred and twenty five dollars, being the one eighth part of the purchase money, which we assign to the widow - five other bonds of one hundred forty five dollars & 83 Cents each which we assign over in the following manner. One to James Bishop in right of his wife one to Jesse B Drake one to Benjamin Story in right of his wife - One to Drewry Beale and one other to Levi Beale - also two other bonds for seventy two dollars & 91 Cents each to the guardians of Willis & Sally Beale infants of John Beale decd. Given under our hands this 17th day of Janry. 1879. Geo. Huntley, John Rochelle, John Thomas". On consideration whereof and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the report afore-
in form aforesaid made be confirmed -
