 decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in manner and form aforesaid made be

This day came the parties by their attorneys and the commissioners appointed under an
 interlocutory decree rendered in this cause at December Court 1818. to allot to the complainant her
 dower in the estate of her deceased husband this day made a report in these words to wit
 "Agreeable to an order of the County Court of Southampton to us directed bearing date December
 Court 1818 We the undersigned have gone on the lands of William Washington dec'd. attended with
 the County Surveyor as by the order we were required have run out the same and find
 there to be 209 Acres in the whole tract: and we have assigned 84 Acres to the Widow
 Peggy Washington relict of the s^d William Washington dec'd. during her natural life and
 bounded as follows to wit: Beginning at the Bridge Ball? the Lightwood Bridge across the
 Lightwood Swamp, thence down the swamp the various Courses thereof to the junction of
 a small branch making into the s^d Swamp, thence along that Branch to a small tree
 a new Cr. made in the corner line near the path leading on by the house thence along that
 path as the same now goes to a Post a new Cr. made on the side of the road leading on
 to John Wiggabarts Store across the said Bridge to the first Station being her full proportion
 able part of the lands of her deceased husband agreeable to quality as well as quantity: And
 in obedience further to same decree we have allotted off and assigned to Peggy Washington
 Widow of said William Washington dec'd during her natural life the following Slaves to wit
 Sam valued at 750 dollars, Esther and Leitia valued at 450 dollars, Sally valued at 100 dollars
 & Simon valued at 350 dollars: Which sums added together makes 1650 dollars: which
 her one third part of all the Slaves of said decedent agreeable to the valuation made
 upon the whole of said negroes. Given under our hands this day of 1819
 John C Gray, Rich^d B Kelle, John Holmes, S. Boykin". On consideration whereof and by
 consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in form aforesaid made
 be confirmed

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb do examine State and settle an account Current of
 the administration on William's Estate and make report thereof to Court -

Matthew Williams orphan of John Williams deceased with the approbation of the Court made
 choice of Mary Williams for his guardian whereupon the said Mary Williams together with
 Joseph Williams and George Williams her securities entered into and acknowledge a bond in
 the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs -
