As there was not time on the day of sale to make the calculations necessary for a distribution your commissioners took bonds and securities from the purchasers to the commissioners for the full amount of their several purchases, with a view so soon as the calculations could be made, of taking bonds to the several distributees as by the decree we were directed. But when we called on Mr Benjamin Bull and Mr. Samuel Hearsum to give such notes, they refused to do so, and still refuse. Mr. Samuel Gardner has given such notes on his part as he was requested, but for want of others we cannot make a distribution which by the said decree we are required to do. Your commissioners further report that as they were not authorized, or directed by the decree to execute a deed to the purchasers of the lot of land directed to be sold they have not done so but wait the further order of the Court for that purpose - Given under our hands this 19th June 1819. Jacob Warder, Jesse Parker, Siphthor Warder, Jacob Daughtry. On consideration whereof, and by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that this report of record in manner and form aforesaid made be made conformable. And the Court doth further decree that the said commissioners execute a deed of conveyance to the purchaser of the land in the foregoing report mentioned -
