This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the defendants have had legal notice of this motion they were solemnly called but came not therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff may have execution against the said defendants for four hundred and twenty seven dollars and eight cents the penalty of the said bond and his costs by him in this behalf expended and the said Defendants in mercy &c. But this execution may be discharged by the payment of two hundred and fourteen dollars and ninety cents with six per cent per annum interest thereon from the 23^d day of February 1819 till paid and the costs.

On the motion of Sally Knox the Executrix named in the last Will & Testament of Isaac M. Knox deceased, who made oath and together with John Barnes, Jacob Darden Jesse Holt and Benjamin Barnes her securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs Certificate is granted her for claiming goods of the said Will in any form.

Ordered that John Thomas, Healdway Revel, Jesse Holt and Edwin Vleck or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do view and appraise all the personal Estate to them produced of Isaac M. Knox deceased and return such appraisement under their hands to Court.

William M. Glover qualified at the last Court as a deputy Sheriff of Richard Polmonds Sheriff of this County which is ordered to be entered of record.

Richard Stephenson is appointed Surveyor of the road from Mount Hill bridge to the Lightwood Bridge and it is ordered that the male labouring whites that usually work on said road do attend and assist the said Surveyor in repairing the said road as repair when required.
