John Vick this day produced to the Court the docket receipt for the transiency by Law and gave bond with security as the Law directs, and it appearing to the Court that the said John Vick is a man of honesty, probity and good demeanor and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming, and that he will keep an orderly and useful house of entertainment. It is therefore ordered that he be licensed to keep a Tavern at his house till the first day of May next.

Hannah Ricks with Joseph Prettan her security here in Court acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Excellency James P. Preston Esq. Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth and his Successors in Office for the time being, the said Hannah in the sum of fifty dollars and the said Joseph in the sum of twenty five dollars to be levied of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements and to the said Governor for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition. If the said Hannah Ricks shall personally appear before the Judge of our Superior Court of Southampton County at the Courthouse on the first day of the next Superior Court by 10 O'clock of that day then and there to abide the judgment of the Court and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court then this recognizance to be void -

Ordered that the account of Spencer R. Jenkins amounting to \$5.84 cents be Certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his Examination and payment.

An Account Current of the Estates of Spencer R. Esq. Silas Drake dec'd was returned into Court and ordered to be recorded.

Abner Hindrick was this day brought into Court for a contempt. Whereupon it is ordered that he find security for his good behavior for twelve calendar months and in default thereof that he be committed to Jail. Thereupon the said Abner Hindrick with Levi Waller and Charles Bryant his securities here in Court acknowledged themselves indebted to his Excellency James P. Preston Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia that is to say the said Hindrick in the sum of fifty dollars and his said securities in the sum of twenty five dollars each to be levied of their respective goods and chattels lands & tenements and to our said Governor or his successors for the time being for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Hindrick shall keep the peace and be of good behavior towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth for the space of twelve calendar months from this time then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force -
