The last Will and Testament of Randolph Museum deceased was proved by the oaths of Sally Sharpe, Benjamin Barnes, and Elvira Fisher the witnesses thereto Vouched to be recorded and in the motion of David Museum the Executor therein named who made oath and together with Robert Nicholas, James Myrick and John I Richardson his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form liberty being reserved for the Executor therein named to join in the said probat when he thinks fit -

Ordered that Thomas Ridley, Spratley Williams William B Goodwyn & Francis Ridley any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do view and appraise all the personal Estate of Randolph Museum deceased and return such appraisement under their hands to Court -

Heardley Harris and Jefe Daley who have been appointed Constables for this County came into Court and took the several oaths required for their qualifications and severally entered into and acknowledged their bonds with security conditioned as the Law directs, which bonds were acknowledged by the Clerks and ordered to be recorded -

Ordered that Mewit Harris, Benjamin Rhunt and Samuel Turner any three of them do examine State and settle the administration on Temperance Turner Estate & make report thereof to Court -

The Court after due consideration are of opinion that James Jones of this County has disqualified himself as County Surveyor of this County by accepting an appointment under the Government of the United States -

Benjamin Cobb is by the Court appointed Surveyor of the road from the bridge at Mrs Ballers near the gate to the barn Tavern in the room of George Hobbs discharged and it is ordered that the male labouring tilthabes that usually work on the said road do attend and assist in keeping the said road in repair when required -

The last Will and Testament of James Maget deceased was proved by the oath of Eam Wick, John Hargrave and John Whitfield witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded, and in the motion of Mamma Maget the Executor therein named who made oath according to Law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form on his giving bond and security whereupon the said Mamma Maget with Solomon Rockelle, William & Everett, and William Owens his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of thirty thousand dollars conditioned according to Law -
