By consent of parties it is ordered that the Commissioners heretofore appointed in this cause have leave to amend their report and that Jeremiah Cobb, and James Jones be appointed Commissioners in addition to those heretofore appointed in this cause and that any two of the said Commissioners make report of their proceedings in the premises to this Court in order to a final decree.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb do examine, State and settle the account current of the Administration of Willie Underwoods Estate and make report thereof to Court.

Upon the petition of Alexander P. Pate setting forth that he is bound as security in this Court, for James Jones Executor of Henry Jones deceased and that he conceives himself to be in danger of suffering thereby. It is therefore ordered that the said Henry Jones be summoned to the next Court to give the said Alexander P. Pate counter security or render up the estate for his indemnification.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent money in his hands not otherwise appropriated pay to John Lear four dollars the amount of his account and account with the Court.

Ordered that Robert Raulings with the male labouring titheables belonging to the plantations of Joseph Vick which formerly belonging to the heirs of John Thomas dec'd the plantation belonging to the heirs of Joseph Drewry dec'd the plantations of Robert Raulings, Daniel Wick and Henry Briggs keep in repair the road called Browns road from the fork of the same and the road leading from Browns bridge to Smithfield to the corner of Thomas Gray and Henry Briggs' line on the said road, according to Law.

Ordered that Richard Pond with the male labouring titheables belonging to the plantations of Thomas Gray, which formerly belonging to the following persons, Eliza Gray, Esmer Gray and William Kitchen the plantations of Richard Pond, Rachel Pond, Pamelia Pond, John Morris and Richard Blows do place keep the road in repair from the corner of Henry Briggs and Thomas Gray's line on Browns road to the fork thereof, and the hunting road according to Law.
