To Mary E Blunt Dary \$600. To Martha P Bonner Lucy & Peter \$600 - To James R Blunt Solomon \$600. To Samuel Blunt Milly and Chloe Richard \$600 - Given under our hands this thirtieth day of December 1817. Spradley, Williams, Thomas Ridley, Stith & Nicholson."
