This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the defendants have had legal notice of this motion they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff may have execution against the said defendants for one thousand and thirty three dollars and twenty eight cents the penalty of the said bond and his costs by him in this behalf expended and the said defendants in May 1859. But this execution may be discharged by the payment of sixty six dollars and sixty four cents with legal interest from the 3rd of June 1859 till paid and the costs.

An Indenture of bargain and sale from James Scammell and Lucy Scammell his wife to Thomas Ridley was acknowledged by the said Scammell to be his act and deed and together with a certificate of the spring Examination thereto annexed taken before two Justices of the Peace are ordered to be recorded.

Elias Luter orphan of John Luter with the approbation of the Court made choice of Joseph Syner for his Guardian, whereupon the said Joseph Syner with Henry Syner and Jonathan Luter his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs.
