

The Court doth recommend James Jones to his Excellency the Governor as a fit & proper person to execute the Office of County Surveyor of this County

The Court doth assign John Vick's guardian to Rhodes Gay orphan of James Gay, and thereupon the said John Vick with John Davis and Willis Wellons his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs -

An Account Current of Joseph Harris administrator of William Barnes and sons returned into Court with the Master Commissioners report thereon and ordered to lie two months for exceptions -

Lewis C. Truitt 2^d Lieutenant in said company in the room of John H. Chapman promoted. All of whom are recommended to the Executive as fit persons to execute the Offices to which they are respectively appointed & ordered
