

the testimony as well the circumstances touching the case, are of opinion that the prisoner ought to be tried for the murder whereof he stands charged, in the Superior Court of Southampton County to be holden in & for the said County, on the first day of September next, and the Court being of opinion that the Prisoner may be bailed himself in the sum of One thousand dollars and two securities in the sum of five hundred dollars each. Whereupon the said Thomas C Jones, with James D Mapenburg and Nathaniel Newsum his securities here in Court acknowledged themselves to be indebted unto his Excellency James P. Prator Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth the said Thomas C Jones in the sum of one thousand dollars and the said James D Mapenburg and Nathaniel Newsum each in the sum of five hundred dollars, of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to our said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. But upon this condition that if the said Thomas C Jones shall personally appear before the Judge of our Superior Court of Southampton on the first day of September next at 12 O'clock of that day at the Courthouse, there and there to abide and perform the Judgment of that Court, and shall not depart thence without the leave of the Court, then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

Be it remembered that James D Mapenburg, Carter Edmunds, & Henry Sealey here in Court acknowledged themselves to be indebted unto his Excellency James P. Prator or Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth and his successors in Office, each in the sum of three hundred thirty three and one third dollars of their respective lands and tenements goods and chattels to be levied, to the said Governor for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. But upon this condition of they and each of them shall severally make their appearance before the Judge of our Superior Court of Southampton at the Courthouse by 12 O'clock on the first day of September next, there and there to give such testimony as they and each of them know or believe of the Commonwealth against Thomas C Jones touching the murder of Jeffry a negro man slave and shall not depart thence without the consent of the Court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and effect.
