Whereupon satisfactory proof being made to the Court of the extraordinary amount of the applicant in this that she has raised a white child indebted to her care from its infancy, and proof of her general good character and conduct being also made to appear to the Court, It is ordered that the said Pat with her children be with William, Tom, Chloe, Malinda, Peter, Miller, Dick & Eliza be permitted to remain within the Commonwealth and to reside within this County, in pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided - and James Jackson entered into bond with security conditioned to prevent either of the said negroes from becoming chargeable to the County.

On the motion of Dempsey Bryant for leave to remain in this County. This day came as well the said Dempsey as the Commonwealth's Attorney who defended the said motion and it appearing to the Court that notice of this application has been posted at the front door of
