Daughtry, & Benjamin Watson or any three be commissioners appointed by the Court to assign to Priscilla Maget Widow and Relict of Samuel Maget dec'd one third part of his Estate both real and personal of which he died seized and possessed as her dower therein - that the said commissioners be attended by a surveyor - It is further ordered by the Court that the commissioners allot to Priscilla Maget her dower out of the slaves not specifically devised, if there shall be a sufficiency, if otherwise out of the Estate whole slaves without any respect to legacies - that the said commissioners report to this Court to this Court in order to a final decree -
