

accordingly. and thereupon the said Pelly Brock and Thomas E Brock being fully heard it is the opinion of the Court after hearing all the testimony and accordingly ordered that the said Thomas E Brock give security for his good behaviour for the term of twelve months, that is to say himself in the sum of fifty dollars with one security in the sum of fifty dollars. And thereupon the said Thomas E Brock with James Wlythe his security here in Court acknowledged themselves indebted to James P. Preston Esq Governor of this Commonwealth the said Thomas E Brock in the sum of fifty dollars and the said James Wlythe in the like sum of fifty dollars of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements to be levied and to our said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered and set upon this condition that if the said Thomas E Brock shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth, and especially towards the said Pelly Brock for the term of six months as aforesaid then this judgment shall be void.
