That he also shew to this Court what proportion of each of the aforesaid legacies hath been sold by the Executor for the payment of debts and which of the legacies to the two Complainants and the defendant Francis is to abate and to what amount. It is further ordered that after having made up the foregoing Statements that he allot to the defendants John Barham and his wife one third of the slaves which now are of the Estate of the said Francis Clements for and during the lifetime of his said wife as and for her dower in the same taking care to assign the dower slaves as equally as possible out of each legatee proportion specifically devised to them having regard to the value of the
