On the motion of John Pleasant, it is ordered that the Sheriff of this County to whom the Estate of Richard Williams has been committed for administration do out of the said Estate if so much he hath in his hands, pay unto the said John Pleasant, the sum of \$15.17^{1/2} cents with interest thereon from the 15th December 1811 till paid subject to a credit of \$19 67 1/2 cents paid 22nd June 1819, and the costs of this motion -

Ordered that the Account of Richard B Clements late Sheriff amounting to \$17.66 Cents be certified to the Auditor for his examination and payment
