

Further adjudge and decree that the said Commissioners or such of them as may act, are authorized and required to demand and receive of the said defendant as Administrator aforesaid so much money as may be necessary to equalize the shares aforesaid, or as may be required for the purpose of making division as above directed and make report to Court in order to a final decree.

On the motion of Richard D. Blount late Sheriff and Comptroller of the Estate of Edwin Dwell dec'd. It is ordered that the creditors of said Dwell present their claims at March Court next in order that arrangements may be made for the settlement thereof and it is ordered that a copy of this order be posted at the front door of the Court House of this County without delay.

Daniel Williams having procured to the Court the Sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by Law. It is ordered that he have leave to keep an ordinary at his house till the first day of May next upon his giving bond.

Nathaniel Mussum gave bond with security in the penalty of one thousand dollars, conditioned as the Law directs, as Comptroller of the Revenue for Saint Luke's parish in this County.

On the motion of Lewis Morrill who made oath and together with Richard Blunt and James Barratt his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty five hundred dollars conditioned according to Law. Certificate is granted the said Lewis Morrill for obtaining letters of Administration in the estate of Jordan Webb dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Augustine Pope, Drury Bryant, James Taylor and William Vick or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal Estate to them procured of Jordan Webb dec'd and return such appraisement under their names to Court.
