

due consideration thereof had, the Court doth assigne, order and decree, that Simon Murfee, Sife Parker, Henry Gardner and Milla Murfee or any three of them do set apart by proper sales and bounds one third in value of the lands of which Richmond Ollard's said seized lying in this County, including the Dwelling house, and all the same to the complainant Sally for and during her natural life and that they also allot to the complainant in right of the said Sally one third in value of the slaves of which said Richmond Ollard's said possessed with their subsequent increase, for and during the natural life of the said Sally and that they or any three of them also divide the balance of the said slaves equally, having regard to value between the infant defendants and it is ordered that they make a report to this Court in order to a final decree -

John Deles nephew of Arthur Deles with the approbation of the Court made choice of Elias Sumner for his Guardian and thereupon the said Elias Sumner with John Clayton and Patrick Deles his stewards entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs -

Abraham Carr who stands bound by a recognizance entered into before Benjamin Griffin a Justice of the Peace for this County for his appearance here this day to answer the Complaint of Rebecca Carr against him for breach of the peace appeared in Court accordingly, and thereupon he being fully heard it is the opinion of the Court accordingly, and that the said Complaint be dismissed -

Ordered that Alexander Driggs, Rowell Harrison, and Benjamin Turner being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do view the way proposed for turning the road through John Persons plantation as well as the present way, and report to the Court truly and impartially the comparative convenience and inconvenience that will result as well to individuals as to the public of such alteration should be made -

Samuel Revell who was recognized to appear here this day to answer for a misdemeanor committed by him tending to a breach of the Peace this day appeared accordingly, and being fully heard it is the opinion of the Court and accordingly ordered that the said Samuel Revell be discharged and the said Complaint dismissed -

Anthony Woodward Guardian to Susan Porter, George Russell, and Mary Porter this day returned accounts of his said wards Estates which were sworn to and ordered to be recorded -

Ordered that Simon Murfee, Milla Murfee, Henry Gardner and Sife Parker or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise the personal estate of Richmond Ollard's dec'd and make report thereof to Court -

Thomas Gray having obtained an attachment against the estate of John Whitfield who hath removed himself out of this Commonwealth, and the Sheriff having returned that he had attached eight head of Cattle, and one petty auger of the goods and chattels of the said John Whitfield this day came the said Thomas Gray by his attorney and the said Whitfield being solemnly called and not appearing, the said Attachment was continued till tomorrow -
