Leah Bowers is appointed Surveyor of the road from his gate to the new bridge, and it is ordered that the hands of Leah Bowers, Mills Hatfield, Joshua Syner, John Barrell, John Barnes, Elisha Syner, and Stephen Johnson do work thereon when required -
