Richard Nelson who stands charged with having feloniously stolen Joseph Mursault, this
day appeared in Court according to the condition of his recognizance, and being set to the bar
in custody of the keeper of the Jail of this county, and thereupon diverse witnesses were sworn
and examined on behalf of the Commonwealth touching the premises to wit, Richard Murfee
Matthew Gardner, Thomas Adams, James Scoggins, Alexander Booth, Edward Lawrence &
Joseph Mursault, and the prisoner fully heard by Council, Whereupon the Court after
hearing the testimony and all circumstances being weighed are of opinion that the prisoner is
not guilty of the felony aforesaid, and thereupon proclamation being made as the manner
is and nothing further being alleged against him it is ordered that he be forthwith discharged
from further prosecution for said offence.

On the motion of Norvington Ellis who hath filed his bill and made oath thereto according to law
an injunction is awarded him to stay, until the further order of this Court, all proceedings on a
judgment therein obtained on the day of 18 by Thomas Harrison Administrator of
Sarah Harrison upon the said Ellis's filing bond with good security in the Clerk's Office and
conditioned as the Law directs within two months.

On the motion of Claiborne Scott It is ordered to be certified to the Secretary of the war
department, that it appears to the satisfaction of the Court by the testimony of Drury
Waller and Edwin Rice taken in open Court that the said Claiborne Scott is the brother
and that Nancy Scott, Martha Bally, and Peggy Scott are the sisters of John V Robert Scott
who it is said died in the Service of the United States, and that the said John V Robert
Scott left no father nor mother, brother or sister except the foregoing nor any descendant of any
such brother or sister.

On the motion of Samuel Whitfield the Executor named in the last Will and Testament of
Benjamin Whitfield deceased who made oath and together with Robert Fishburn, Lewis Cornell
and Williams Vick his Securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of
Six thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs certificate is granted the said
Samuel White for obtaining a probat of the said decedent's will heretofore proved and recorded
in due form.

On the motion of Alexander P Peale who made oath and together with James H Foster
and H. P. Westbrooke his Securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of
five hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate is granted the said Alexander P
Peale for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Joel Jay deceased in due form.
