Williams Shands Esq. who hath been duly licensed to practice the Law in the Courts of this Commonwealth, on his motion has leave to practice in this Court, and therefore he took the oath of fidelity to the Commonwealth, the oath of an Attorney at Law, and the oath to support the Constitution of the United States -

Lucas Gardner who hath been appointed a Justice of the Peace for this County by a Commission from the Governor with the seal of the Commonwealth thereto affixed, then appeared in Court and took the oath of fidelity to the Commonwealth, the several oaths of Office, the oath prescribed by the act entitled "An act to suppress duelling" and the oath to support the Constitution of the United States -
