The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner is not guilty of the felony aforesaid and thereupon proclamation being made as the manner is and nothing further appearing or being alleged against the prisoner it is ordered that he be discharged from further prosecution for said offence -
