

The Court doth assign Lucy Long Guardian to Joshua, Margaret, and Sally Hutchins orphans of Carter Hutchins dec^d and thereupon she together with Joseph Harris and John dollars conditioned according to Law.

On the motion of John E Birdsong who made oath according to Law and together with Elsha Butler and William Whitfield his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to Law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Sally Birdsong dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Benjamin Barnes, Jacob Barnes, James Sandiford and George Whitfield or any three of them being sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do truly & justly according to the best of their skill and judgment appraise all the personal estate of Sally Birdsong dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of John Stith who made oath according to Law and together with James D Maffenburg his security entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned according to Law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Margaret R Stith dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Reubin Kitcher, Thomas E Corby, Jacob Murdaugh, Henry Gurley and James Rochelle or any three of them being first duly sworn for that purpose do according to the best of their skill and judgment view and appraise all the personal estate of Margaret E Stith dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to the Court.

An Inventory and Appraisement of Winshaw Colles Estate was returned into Court and ordered to be recorded.

Archibald Gardner, orphans of Sally Gardner with the approbation of the Court made choice of Samuel Daughtry for his Guardian and thereupon the said Samuel with Frederick Holt, Elias Edwards and Solomon Daughtry his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand Dollars conditioned as the Law directs.

On the motion of Goodrich Wells who made oath according to Law and together with John Scarborough and John Williams his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, certificate is granted the said Goodrich Wells for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of his deceased wife Rebecca Wells in due form.

On the motion of Lewis Morrill who hath filed his bill and made oath thereto according to Law, an injunction is awarded him to stay, until the further order of the Court, all proceedings on a judgment therein obtained by Lucinda Whitehead against the said Lewis Morrill. But the plaintiff is not to have the benefit of this order unless he shall enter into bond with good security within one month from this time, in a penalty equal to double the amount of the said judgment with such condition as the Law requires, and until he shall also file with the Clerk a release of all errors at Law in the said judgment and proceedings on.
