

The proceper master in present Mr. Having reported that a line was in dispute between Thomas Mearns and William Barnes. Whereupon it is ordered that the surveyor of this County with a jury do lay out and proceper the bound so in dispute at the charge of the party against whom the right to such bounds shall be determined, and return such survey with the proceedings thereon to the next Court after the said survey shall be made.

On the motion of James Mearns setting forth that he is bound in this Court as security of John Edmunds for his Guardianship of Edmund Underwood orphan of Miller Underwood and praying to be relieved, it is ordered that the said John Edmunds be summoned to the first day of the next Court to answer the said petition. And it is further ordered that the said John Edmunds do render an account of his Guardianship before Master Commissioner Cobb who is directed to examine same and settle the same and make report thereof to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

On the motion of George Hurley Executor of Jacob Clark dec'd. It is ordered that Richard P. Clement late Sheriff of this County and Committee of Richard Clark retain in his hands all the money, goods and effects of said Estate till the further order of said Court.

Upon the petition of Alexander P. Pate setting forth that he is the owner of the land on one side of the Three creeks, and that he is desirous of erecting a water grist mill on the said stream, and praying that an acre of land on the opposite side of the said stream may be laid out on which he may abut his dam. It is therefore ordered that a writ of ad quod damnum be awarded him accordingly to law to be executed on the 4th day of August next.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County furnish the necessary bolts and locks &c to the jail of this County and pay for the same out of any contingent money in his hands.

On the motion of Thomas E. Holliday It is ordered that Henry S. Westbrooks be summoned to the next Court to render an account current of his Guardianship of said Holliday.

Robert Rockelle who was summoned to give Clement Rockelle (one of his sureties for the Guardianship of Zebulon Lewis's orphans) counter security. This day gave bond with Calvin Turner and Nathaniel D. Lund his securities in the penalty of twenty thousand dollars, - and whereupon the said Clement Rockelle is discharged.

On the motion of Augustine Pope who made oath and together with Anthony Woodward and Brethron Bryant his sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to law. Certificate is granted the said Augustine Pope for Administering letters of administration on the estate of John Johnson dec'd in due form.

Ordered that William H. Barnes, Joseph Pope, Miller Syner, and Jafe Holt Jr. or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace do view and appraise all the personal Estate of John Johnson deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
