

Defendant Jacob Ely hath been made, and he failing to appear to file his answer to the Complainant's bill, the same is taken for confessed as to him. Whereupon it is decreed and ordered that the said defendant Ely who appears to be an obligor to the bond mentioned in his answer do pay to the Complainant Darius one half of the amount of the Judgment together with his own legal costs one half of the amount of the Complainant's costs in this suit which together in the bill mentioned and the Complainant's costs in this suit which together with his own legal costs are to constitute a credit on the said note and that he forthwith deliver up the said note to the said Complainant for collection he having given bond and security according to Law to account therefor when called on.

It is ordered that the Sheriff of this County to those hands the Estate of Edwin Phillips has been committed pay unto the said Bayliss the sum of four pounds five shillings with interest from the 17<sup>th</sup> December 1841 till paid the amount of his note, and also the costs of this motion. Whereof sufficient shall come to his hands to be administered.

On the motion of William Exum who made oath according to Law and together with Ethelred Clasper and Patrick Pond his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Thomas Adams deceased in due form.

Ordered that Leatham Pond, John Shield, John Exum, and William Hicks or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do view and appraise all the personal Estate of Thomas Adams deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to the Court.
