And have made the following distribution of the proceeds thereof to wit: To Thomas Harrison the sum of Seven hundred and sixty nine dollars and twenty eight cents as his proportion of said Estate. To Sally Davis formerly Harrison the sum of seven hundred and sixty nine dollars and twenty eight cents as her proportion of said Estate. To David Westbrooke Guardian of Rebecca Person, heir and distributee of her mother Sally formerly Harrison, the sum of Seven hundred and sixty nine dollars and twenty eight cents as her proportion of said Estate. To Henry Harrison the sum of seven hundred and sixty dollars and twenty eight cents as his proportion of said Estate. To Jeremiah P. Johnson in right of his wife Lucretia, formerly Harrison, the sum of Seven hundred and sixty nine dollars and twenty eight cents as his proportion of said Estate. Leaving a balance in the hands of Wm. J. Smith one of said Commissioners of twenty three hundred and seven dollars & 85 cents for distribution, which several legacies herein disposed of including the above balance, makes the aforesaid sum of six thousand one hundred and fifty four dollars and twenty five cents, which is respectfully submitted to the Court. Given under our hands this 16th day of October One thousand eight hundred and twenty. Lewis Harris, Benjamin Turner, Wm. J. Smith. Whereupon by consent of the parties by their Attorneys it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in form aforesaid made be confirmed between the parties and that each party pay his proportion of the costs, and that the parties jointly do pay the Commissioners who acted in this case the sum of twenty dollars each for their services in dividing the Estate.

Ordered that Benjamin Briffen, Joseph Crocker, Robert Rawlings and John Drury or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate to the executors of Polly Jones dec'd. and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.
