This day this cause was docketed and came on by consent of parties and the report of
the Court, to be heard upon the bill and answer when it is ordered and decreed that George
Hurley Sr. Lawrence Cook, Anthony Woodward and George Hurley Jr. or any three of them be
Commissioners appointed by the Court, to make sale of the tract of land lying and being
in this County belonging to the Estate of John Johnson dec. containing by estimation one
hundred and forty four acres be the same more or less upon a credit of twelve months, having
first advertised the time and place of the same and that they take four separate bonds
with good and sufficient security from the purchaser, and assign one bond to Samuel Black
in right of his wife Elizabeth, one bond to Belling Johnson and the two remaining bonds to
the Guardians or Guardians of Beatty and Miles Johnson, and that the said Commissioners
or two of them as may act make a report to this Court in order to a final decree -

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cook settle an account of Alexander P. Pate as Curator
of the Estate of James Miller deceased and make report thereof to Court -

The Court with assign John Rivers Guardian to Robert Rivers orphan of John Rivers
deceased and thereupon the said John Rivers with Arthur Williamson and George Jey
his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of six thousand
dollars conditioned according to Law -

On the motion of Harrison Stephenson who made oath and together with William
Hamcock & Jesse Bailey his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the
penalty of fifteen hundred dollars - conditioned according to Law, Certificate is
granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the Estate of Temperance
Turner dec. in due form -

Ordered that William Hamcock, Jesse Bailey, David Byker, and Stephen Holliman
or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that
purpose to appraise the personal Estate of Temperance Turner deceased and return
the appraisement under their hands to Court -

Edith Harris orphan of James Harris deceased with the approbation of the Court
made choice of Joseph Gilliam for her Guardian and thereupon the said Joseph Gilliam
together with Arthur Williamson, William J. Smith and George Jey his securities
entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twenty thousand dollars condi-
tioned according to Law -

Alexander P. Pate having obtained an Attachment against the goods and chattels
of Nancy Jey his tenant for rent for \$85 which will become due on the 1st day of
November next, and the Constable having by virtue thereof Levied on one David
man, This day came as well the plaintiff by his Attorney as the defendant by her
