The Commissioners appointed under and interlatory decree made in this cause to make division of the lands &c in the proceedings mentioned this day made their report in these words to wit: "Agreeable to a decree of the County Court of Southampton to us directed bearing date November Court 1819. We the undersigned have gone on the lands of Charles B. Nicholson dec'd attended with the County Surveyor and have surveyed the same and found there to be 930 Acres in the whole. We have then proceeded to make an equal distribution agreeable to quality as well as quantity as by the oath we were required in manner and form following (to wit) Lot N^o 1. being the house lot drawn by John Nicholson containing 201 Acres and bounded as follows Beginning at a white oak a new cr. made between lots 1st & 2nd which will fully appear by having reference to the Plat annexed to this report. thence S 66^o W 60 pole to a small red oak a cr. of Majr Drury standing on the side of a branch thence up the said branch the various courses thereof to the three creeks at the place called the gum root thence down the three creek the various courses thereof to a willow oak new cr. made on the side of S^o Creek between John Nicholson's lot N^o 1 and Evelina Nicholson's lot N^o 2. thence along the dividing line of John Nicholson and Evelina Nicholson S 2^o E 300 Pole to the first Station - being her full proportionable part of all the lands of her deceased father -

Also Lot N^o 2 drawn by Evelina Nicholson containing 233 Acres and bounded as follows Beginning at a white oak a new corner made in the lot N^o 1 & 2 thence N 66^o E 20 pole thence N 45^o E 94 pole to a Black Jack standing on the side of the road a corner of Majr Drury thence along the road S 55^o E 78 pole to a white oak a new cr. made in Lots N^o 2 & 3 and Majr Drury's line thence along the dividing line of Lots N^o 2 & 3 between Evelina Nicholson and Henry P. Nicholson N 45^o W 35 pole to a new cr. of Lots N^o 2 & 3 on the side of the three creeks thence up the S^o creeks the various courses thereof to a willow oak a new cr. of Lots N^o 1 & 2 on the creek side thence along the dividing line of Lots N^o 1 & 2 S 2^o E 300 pole to the first Station being her full proportionable part of all the lands of her dec'd father. Also Lot N^o 3 drawn by Henry P. Nicholson containing 233 Acres and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a new cr. of Lots N^o 2 & 3 on the side of the road thence S 33^o E 82 pole to a variation on the road thence S 55^o E 72 pole

to a red oak a new cr. of Majr Drury's fence, thence up the S^o creek between Lots N^o 1 & 2 to the first Station his deceased father's acres and bounded near Majr Drury's fence S 68^o E 18 pole to a new cr.
