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the bounds so in dispute at the charge of the party against whom the right to such bounds shall be determined and return such survey with the proceedings thereon to the next Court after the same survey shall be made.

Jacob Rocks who was bound by a recognizance for his appearance here this day to answer a complaint against him for a breach of the Peace appeared accordingly and being heard it is ordered that the said complaint be dismissed.
