This day came the parties by their counsel and the persons appointed for dividing the lands of Thomas Cobb dec. this day made the following report to Court—
In obedience to the ordered decree we the undersigned have proceeded to divide the lands of Thomas Cobb dec. in manner as follows. First let us appear on the within plot to Mildreda Cobb as demise right containing by Survey 3 1/2 Acres—
Lot A. 2 to Brettain Britt in right of his wife Temperance, containing by Survey as appears by the within plot 66 Acres—
Lot A. 3 to James H. Edwards in right of his wife Patsy containing by Survey as appears by the within plot 8 1/2 Acres.
Lot A. 4 to Lucy Cobb containing by Survey as appears in the within plot 3 1/2 Acres.

Also we the undersigned proceeded to divide the lands of said dec. & mentioned in said decree in manner following. The said defendant Mildreda Cobb being willing to receive as her equal with the children in stead of her thirds and divided as follows.

All of which we the undersigned submit to the honorable Court of Southampton January 15th 1821. S. Munroe, Frederick Cobb. Whereupon by consent of parties it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesaid in form of record be confirmed and the costs equally borne between the parties—

The Jury impeached to run out the line between Spratley Williams & the lands belonging to the estate of Benjamin Bille dec. not having run the said line. Therefore it is ordered that the Sheriff summon a Jury to go on the premises on the 17th day of February next and run out the line according to law.

The Surveyor of this County pursuant to an order made at December Court last this day returned a Survey and report relative to the bounds of the land between Brettain Bryant & Lawrence Cook and it is ordered that the said Survey and report be recorded, that the lines as therein mentioned be established between the parties and that the said Lawrence Cook pay to the said Brettain Bryant his costs—
