It appearing by due proof made to the Court that Nathaniel Pierce hath permitted his negro man slave named Jacob (who hath been committed to the jail of this County) to go at large and have himself out. It is therefore ordered that the said Nathaniel Pierce be fined the sum of twenty dollars for the use of the Commonwealth and that he also pay the costs in this behalf incurred. and it is further ordered that the said slave be held in possession of the Sheriff of this County, liable to the said fine till the same be paid, or that be done within ten days from the date hereof: but if the said Nathaniel Pierce shall fail to pay the same on or before the expiration of the said ten days, that then the said Sheriff provide to sell the said slave to the highest bidder for ready money having given reasonable previous notice of the time and place of sale: and out of the money arising from said sale pay the said fine of twenty dollars and all incidental charges attending the said sale. But if the said Nathaniel shall pay the said fine, and costs within ten days from the date hereof then the said slave is to be discharged -
