money and return it to the Court as the proportion to which the infant complain-
ants are entitled, and one other bond for $\frac{1}{4}$ and assign the same to the def-
endants Caprell and the Guardian of the infant defendants. And it is further
ordered that the aforesaid persons or such of them as may act herein do
make do make a conveyance of fee simple to the purchaser of said land
and also make a report to this Court of their proceedings herein in order to
a final decree.
