On the motion of Arthur Williamson It is ordered that he leave leave to keep an Ordinary at his house within this County till the first day of May next upon his paying the Tax imposed by Law and entering into bond with good security as the Law directs. It appearing to the Court that he is a man of honesty probity and good demeanor and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming and that he will keep an orderly and useful house of Entertainment—

Edward Hargill late of Borough of Norfolk was set to the Bar by the Sheriff of this County into whose custody he was therefore committed and charged with felonies by Stealing, taking, and carrying away, from the dwelling house of Doctor John Saunders of this County on the 3^d of April last past between seven and eight hundred dollars in specie and notes of the State Bank of North Carolina the property of the said Doctor John Saunders: and also for feloniously Stealing, taking and carrying away two horses & one mule the property of the said Doct. John Saunders in the County of Southampton on the third day of April last past, and also for assaulting and putting in bodily fear and danger of his life the said Doctor John Saunders of this County and one money purse of the value of one dollar and fifty cents and between seven eight hundred dollars in specie and notes of the State Bank of North Carolina of the goods and chattels of the said Doctor John Saunders from the person and against the will of the said Doctor John Saunders, feloniously and voluntarily did take steal and carry away (the Court summoned for his Examination not having met) and thereupon two witnesses were sworn and examined in behalf of the Commonwealth touching the premises to wit Doct. John Saunders & Dempsey McCumple and Jefe Mumble and the prisoner being fully heard by Counsel. The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the said Edward Hargill ought to be tried for the said offence at the next Superior Court to be holden for this County and thereupon he is remanded to Jail.

But it remembered that John Saunders, Pompey M Campbell and Jesse Womble
here in Court acknowledged themselves indebted to his Excellency Thomas M Randolph
Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth in the sum of \$353.33 1/2 Cents each
of their respective goods and chattels loaned and returned to be levied and to our said
Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon
