Jonas Archibald late of the Borough of Norfolk was this day set to the Bar by the Sheriff of this County into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with feloniously stealing, taking and carrying away from the Dwelling house of Doct. John Saunders of this County on the 23rd of April last past between seven and eight hundred dollars in specie & notes of the State Bank of North Carolina the property of the said Doct. John Saunders in the County of Southampton on the said 3rd day of April last past, and also on the third day of April last past did feloniously and violently assault and put in bodily fear and danger of his life the said Doct. John Saunders and one money purse of the value of one dollar and fifty cents, and between seven and eight hundred dollars in specie and notes of the State Bank of North Carolina of the goods and chattels of the said Doct. John Saunders from the person and against the Will of the said Doct. John Saunders feloniously and voluntarily did steal take and carry away (The Court summoned for his examination not having met) And thereupon deus witnesses were sworn and examined in behalf of the Commonwealth touching the premises, to wit, Mills Whitfield. The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the said Jonas Archer ought to be tried for the said Offence at the next Superior Court to be holden for this County. And thereupon he is remanded to Jail.

And it remembered that Mills Whitfield here in Court acknowledge himself indebted unto his Excellency Thomas M. Randolph Esquire Governor or Chief Magistrate of this Commonwealth in the sum of \$133¹/₂. of this respective goods & chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to our said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition if the said Mills Whitfield shall personally appear before the Judge of our Superior Court of Law of Southampton County at the Court house on the first day of the next Term and shall then and there give such evidence as he knows in behalf of the Commonwealth against Jonas Archer and shall not depart thence without the leave of our said Court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
