Therefore it is considered by the Court that the Judgment pronounced against the said Belia be executed by the Sheriff of this County at the usual place of execution on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August next between the hours of 10 o'clock A.M. & 5 o'clock P.M. of that day and thereupon the prisoner is remanded to Jail -
