On the motion of Spencer R Jenkins against Jordan Mlemwell Executor of the last Will and testament of John Clinch and This day came the plaintiff by his attorney & it appearing to the Court that the defendant hath had legal notice of this motion he was solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of thirty one dollars & seventy five cents with legal interest thereon from the 17th day of February 1821 till paid it being the legal share and proportion that your testator was bound for as joint security with myself to a certain William Strongfield (who was principal & insolvent) in a certain single bill executed to Moody & Wren afterwards assigned to Charles Wren, which said bill has been prosecuted to a judgment which judgment was satisfied out of the plaintiffs property And also that the plaintiff recover of the defendant his costs by him about his motion in this behalf expended To be levied of the goods and chattels of the said John Clinch in the hands of the defendant to be administered if so much thereof he hath if not then the costs to be levied of the proper goods and chattels of the defendant and the said defendant in mercy &c
