Nanny a negro woman Slave the property of the Estate of Richard Driggs dec. who stands charged with preparing and administering medicine to Sally Washington with an ill intent was this day set to the Bar by the Sheriff of this County into whose custody she was heretofore committed and charged with the felony aforesaid, and being thereof arraigned, pleaded not guilty and for her trial put herself upon God & the Court. (The Court of Oyer & Terminer summoned for her trial not having met) and thereupon divers witnesses were sworn and examined on behalf of the Commonwealth touching the premises viz. Peter a negro man Slave the property of Sally Washington and the prisoner being fully heard by Counsel. The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner is not guilty And thereupon proclamation being made as the manner is and nothing further appearing or being alleged against the prisoner it is ordered that she be forthwith discharged from further prosecution.

Peter a negro man Slave the property of Sally Washington of this County was this day set to the Bar by the Sheriff of this County into whose custody he was heretofore committed and charged with administering medicine to the said Sally Washington and being thereof arraigned pleaded not guilty and for his trial put himself upon God and the Court. (The Court summoned for his trial having failed to meet) and thereupon divers witnesses were sworn and examined on behalf of the Commonwealth touching the premises viz. Lewis Branch and Sepe Bailey, and the Prisoner being fully heard by Counsel.

The Court after hearing the testimony and all the circumstances of the case are unanimously of opinion that the prisoner is not guilty and thereupon proclamation being made as the manner is and nothing further appearing or being alleged against the prisoner it is ordered that he be discharged from further prosecution in this behalf.
