Be it remembered that Jeremiah Syner & James Counsel here in Court acknowl-
 edged themselves indebted to his Excellency Thomas M Randolph Esq. Governor or Chief
 Magistrate of this Commonwealth and his Successors in the sum of \$333.33 1/3 cents each of
 their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to our said Governor
 and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that
 if the said Jeremiah Syner and James Counsel shall personally appear before the
 Judge of our Superior Court of Law for this County at the Court House on the first day of
 the next term by 10 o'clock of that day, then and there to give such testimony as
 they and each of them know on behalf of the Commonwealth against Miles Wells who
 stands charged with larceny and shall not depart thence without leave of the Court
 then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.
