Yet upon this condition that if the said Mills Wade shall personally appear before the Judge of the Superior Court of Law of Southampton County at the Court house on the first day of the next Term of the said Superior Court of Law by ten o'clock of that day then and there to abide and perform the order or Judgment of the said Court and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court then this recognition is and to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

On the motion of John Cooper who made oath and together with James Mills and Alexander Booth his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs certificate is granted the said John Cooper for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of his dec^d wife Nancy Cooper in due form.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning nine o'clock. The minutes of the foregoing proceedings were signed by "Jerr Cobb".
