Lundy three dollars the same being his proportion of said slaves. We allot unto Martha
Lundy negro boy Harry and to receive from Henry R Williams three dollars it being her
proportion of the said slaves. We allot unto Mount Davis in right of his wife Elizabeth
negro girl Zenia and to receive from Henry R Williams twenty eight dollars it being his
proportion of the said slaves. We allot unto Byrd Lundy negro woman Lucy & boy Robin
and to receive from Henry R Williams three dollars it being his proportion of the said slaves
given under our hands this 29th day of Decr. 1820. Levi Miller, Peter Edwards, David
Westbrook. Whereupon by consent of the parties it is decreed & ordered that the report
aforesaid in form aforesaid made be held firm & stable the forever binding between the
parties and that the costs be equally borne.
