On the motion of the plaintiffs by counsel and for good cause shown, a writ of injunction is awarded them to restrain the defendants their agents, and all others from doing & committing further waste and destruction upon the tract of land, or the houses, orchards, gardens, fences, timber or wood thereon situated and growing lying and being in the County of Southampton, & near the Meherin River, it being the same tract of land whereof John Kofler did seized & possessed.

James Blythe who stands bound by a recognizance for his appearance here this day to answer the Complaint of William Barnes against him for a breach of the peace has appeared in discharge of the said recognizance, and the said Barnes being solemnly called and not appearing, and the said James Blythe being fully heard it is ordered that the said Complaint be dismissed.

Dixon Gardner of this County, who stands charged by Martha Kaper as oath of this County single woman with being the father of her bastard child, has appeared in discharge of his recognizance entered into before Benjamin Devaney a Justice of the Peace for this County, which recognizance is returned by the said Justice. Whereupon it is ordered that the said recognizance be continued till the next Court.
