The plaintiff James Kelle having departed this life it is therefore ordered that this suit do abate as to him, and the plaintiff Martha P Blunt having intermarried with John W. Wigham it is ordered that this suit in future be proceeded in the name of the said John W. Wigham.

Benjamin Kelle is by the Court appointed a Committee to take into his hands the estate of Michael Ellis & Sonnet, for the safekeeping and good management thereof and thereupon the said Benjamin Kelle together with Jeremiah Kelle his security entered into and acknowledged as bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

On the motion of Norvington Ellis against Richard P Clements Sheriff of this County & Committee of the estate of Aaron Thorpe dec^d. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the said Clements being again solemnly called and not appearing therefore it is considered by the Court that the said Ellis recover against the said Clements Committee as of record the sum of forty dollars and sixty seven cents with legal interest thereon from the 30th day of September 1819 all paid it being the sum paid on that day by the said Ellis as the said Thorpe security at the suit of David M. Westbrook Guardian of Rebecca Persons. And also that the said Ellis recover of the said Clements his costs by him about his motion in this behalf expended. So Believed of the goods and chattels of the said Aaron Thorpe dec^d to the hands of the said Clements to be administered.

On the motion of George H. Hines Sheriff of this County William Myrick is permitted to qualify as his deputy the Court being of opinion that he is a man of honesty, probity and good demeanor. And thereupon the said William Myrick took the several oaths required by Law.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till Court in course.
