

On the motion of Jincy against Richard Clements late Sheriff. This day came the said Jincy by his Attorney and it appearing to the Court that the said Clements had legal notice of this motion it is ordered that the said notice be continued till tomorrow.

Joseph Byrnes who is charged on oath by Sarah Byrnes a single white woman with being the father of her bastard child this day appeared in Court on discharge of his recognizance entered into and being heard, and there being no evidence introduced to support the charge against him it is ordered that the said charge be dismissed.

Upon the petition of Matthew Munfort setting forth that he is bound in this Court as security for Daniel Williams as Guardian to Joshua Corbitts orphan and that he conceives himself to be in danger of suffering damages by reason thereof and praying the Court for relief. It is ordered that the said Daniel Williams be summoned to the first day of the next Court to answer the said petition.

On the motion of Joshua Prollon It is ordered that Henry Briggs late Sheriff of this County and Committee of the Estate of Solomon Turner dec'd pay to the said Joshua Prollon the sum of twenty eight dollars and eighteen cents with Interest from 25th day of September 1814 till paid, the amount of a note executed to Samuel Jones debtor with the will annexed of Joseph Denson dec'd, and the costs of this motion.

Upon the petition of Nathaniel Knight setting forth that he is bound in this Court for Birchey Knight for his due and faithful Administration of the Estate of John Clanton dec'd. and that he apprehends himself to be in danger of suffering damages by reason of his being security as aforesaid, and the said Birchey Knight having been duly summoned and not appearing. On the motion of the said Nathaniel Knight it is ordered that the Estate of the said John Clanton which remains unadministered be committed to the hands of the Sheriff of this County and that he administer the same according to Law.

On the motion of Nathaniel Knight It is ordered that Birchey Knight render an account of his Administration on John Clanton at before Master Commissioner Cobb and that the said Commissioner examine the same and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the Commissioners heretofore appointed to let out the repairs of the South gate bridge with Commissioners appointed by the County Court of Assessment, contract publicly or privately as they may think proper for the repairing or rebuilding said bridge, and receive the said bridge when completed according to contract and make report thereof to Court.

Martha Jones Orphan of Allen Jones with the approbation of the Court made claim of Edwin Bland for her Guardian and thereupon he together with Joseph Bland and Arthur Williamson his sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

Jincy Bland Widow and devisee of Jesse Bland dec'd and Elizabeth Wimperance Black infant Children of and devisee of Jesse Bland dec'd by their mother. Plaintiff against Joseph Bland Executor of Jesse Bland dec'd. Defendant.

This day this cause was docketed by Consent of parties and a part of the Court, and came on to be heard upon the bill answer, exhibits and arguments of Counsel. Whereupon and after due Consideration thereof had the Court with advice, order and decree that the said Joseph Bland render before one of the master Commissioners of this Court an account of his Executorial proceedings of his testator's estate. That the said Commissioner report thereof to the Court all matters and things therein thought pertinent by himself or which he may be required by either of the parties in order to a final decree.
