This cause was this day docketed by consent of parties and spent of the Court and was heard on the bill and answer filed and argument of Counsel whereupon the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the seven slaves, Rob. Hannah, Lucy, & her child Ned, Pat, Jesse & Phillis of which Sallie Boykin was possessed if practicable be divided into seven equal parts in value, and the reversionary interest in the remaining three slaves to which the said Sallie Boykin was entitled at the death of the Complainant, Sallie Boykin, to wit, Anthony, Mason and Jack be sold on a credit of twelve months and the proceeds of the sale be secured by bond with approved security, and divided also into seven equal parts, that two sevenths of the aforesaid slaves and money be allotted to the Complainant Sallie Boykin, one seventh to the Complainant Hardy Harris, one seventh to the defendant John Boykin, Arthur Boykin, and John Boykin Admors of Jesse B Boykin, and the remaining seventh to the Guardian of the infant defendants who are entitled as heirs of their deceased father Edwin, and in case it should not be practicable to effect a division of the first mentioned seven slaves in kind it is decreed and ordered that they as well as the reversionary interest of the said Sallie in the other three be sold in like manner on a credit of twelve months, and the proceeds of the sale be secured by bond with approved security and divided in the same proportions as before directed between the Complainants and defendants, and it is moreover ordered that Richard Blunt, William Phillips, Newt Harris, and Robert Goodwyn or any three of them do carry the foregoing decree into effect and make report to this Court in what manner they have done the same in order to a final decree.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Gray examine State and settle Benjamin Carroll and Sion Gays administration account in Elizabeth Washington estate and make report thereof to Court.

Whereupon the Court doth adjudge, order & decree that one third in value of the land lying in the County of which Edmund Turner decd seized, so that the same be allotted out of the tract on which the said Edmund decd be set apart by proper notes and bonds and allotted to the Complainant Narcissa for her life as her dower in the same - That one third holdish of grist hereafter grounds at the mill of which said Edmund Turner Jr decd, seized and possessed be allotted to the Complainant Narcissa so long as she may live. And that one third of the slaves in value of which the said Edmund Turner Jr decd & possessed be set apart to the Complainant Narcissa for her life and Thomas Turner Jr decd & possessed be set apart to the Complainant Narcissa for her life and Thomas Newsum, William Smith, Mellics Francis and Henry Porter or any three of them are appointed Commissioners to carry the foregoing decree into execution who are required to take with them the County Surveyor to make the aforesaid allotment in the land and to make a report to this Court of their doings in order to a final decree.
