Ordered that William Sney, John Kinney, Joseph H. Johnson, J. Exum Turner or any three of them being sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal Estate of Abraham Carr dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent moneys in his hands pay unto Matthew Cabot eight dollars the amount of his account for guarding and account with the Court.

The Court doth assign Samuell Turner Guardian to James Turner Orphan of Intemperance Turner dec'd and therewith the said Samuell Turner with Benjamin Turner and Hardy Harris his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

An Indenture from Nathan Britt and Mary his wife to William Ferguson was acknowledged by the said Nathan Britt and Mary his wife (the said Mary being privately examined as the Law directs) and orders to be recorded.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb do examine state and settle William White's Administration account in Jacob Stammersell's Estate and make report thereof to Court.

This day this cause came on again to be heard on the Bill answer and arguments of counsel whereupon it is decreed and ordered that George Hurley and James Bishop with persons appointed by a former decree of this Court or any three of them do divide the lands lying and being in this County belonging to the Estate of John Jackson deceased into five equal parts & assign one fifth to Reuben Whitfield in right of his wife Phoebe, one fifth to Mary Jackson two fifths to Sally Knox in right of Jordan and Micajah Jackson - and that the Commissioners sell to the highest bidder the remaining fifth upon a credit of twelve months having first duly advertised the time and place of the sale and take three separate bonds with good security for the same and assign one bond to Matilda Daughtrey, one to Samuel Daughtrey and one to Lawrence Daughtrey in right of their deceased mother Phoebe Lawrence - That the said Commissioners attend by the County Surveyor - and that they report to this Court in order to a final decree.

Dexon Gardner who is charged in oath by Matthew Kasper with being the father of her bastard child this day appeared in Court in discharge of his Recognizance, and being fully heard, it is the opinion of the Court that the said Dexon Gardner be discharged and the complaint against him be dismissed.
