This cause was this day docketed by consent of parties and agent of the Court and upon
hearing and considering the bill and answer and argument of counsel the Court doth adjudge
order and decree that the defendant James Dillard do deliver up the slaves which were allotted
to Sarah Richmond Dillard now dec^d. as her proportion of her deceased father Richmond
Dillard's slaves and that they be sold on a credit of twelve months for the best price that
can be obtained, and the proceeds of the sale be divided into nine equal parts, and the
payment of one separate ninth be secured secured by bonds with good personal security and
delivered to the Guardian of the infant complainant Augustus W. Hart, and one bond be
allotted to the complainant Edwin G. Hart and Sarah his wife in right of his said wife as
her proportion of said slaves to which she is entitled as the mother to the said dec^d. Sarah
Richmond Dillard for one fourth of the balance. One bond to Edwin Harrison and Mary
his wife in right of his said wife Mary who is entitled as one of the sisters of the said
Sarah Richmond Dillard for one fourth of the balance. And one other bond to each of
the Guardians of each of the infant complainants Elizabeth and Nancy Dillard each
for one fourth of the said balance. And it is ordered that James Hopkinson, Jacob
Dardow and Septimus Dardow or any two of them do carry the foregoing decree into effect.
It is also decreed and ordered that the said James Dillard Administrator as aforesaid do
submit his transactions as the Administrator of Richmond Dillard dec^d. to a Commissioner
of this Court for adjustment, who is ordered to make up an account. And finally it is
ordered that the Commissioner of this Court who shall make such account as well as the
aforesaid persons or such of them as may carry into effect the foregoing part of this decree
order do make a report to this Court in order to a final decree.

Edwin Ricks is by the Court appointed Surveyor of the road from the foot of the Bridge at House
Hill to the fork of the road near Mt. Collins in the name of Henry Bentley discharged and it is
ordered the male labouring jethables that heretofore worked on the said road to assist the
said Surveyor in keeping the same in good repair.

Ordered that Master Commissioner Cobb do re-examine, rectify and settle an account
