Whereupon the Court with adjudge, order and decree that the three slaves, Sampson, Anthony and Willis in which Mr. Maria Fort had a life Estate under the will of her husband Joshua Fort, dec. be sold on a credit of twelve months and the proceeds of the sale divided into five equal parts to be secured by bonds with good personal security. That one of said bonds be allotted to the Complainant Samuel Bachman and his wife Elizabeth in right of his wife Elizabeth, one to each of the defendant William Barnes, Temperance Myrick, Robert Fort and Lawrence Cook. It is further ordered that the tract of land to which Edwin Fort died entitled be divided into five equal parts in case it is worth more than three hundred dollars a share, and one equal fifth part be allotted to the Complainants in right of Elizabeth, the wife of Samuel Bachman, one to Robert Fort, one to Temperance Myrick, one to Eliza Fort, and the remaining equally to the three defendants, Presley Barnes, Edwin Barnes, and also Maria Barnes and in case the land is not worth three hundred dollars in the opinion of the Commissioners herein after appointed, then it is decreed that the said land be sold on a credit of twelve months and the proceeds divided into five equal parts and secured by bonds with approved security, and the land allotted to the Complainants and the said named defendants in the same proportions, and it is ordered that the persons appointed to carry this decree into effect do make proper Dues of
